Howdy all,

I missed the Nov HPD match as did 49er Preacher, Wylie Fox, Tumbleweed Ed and Ogallala Kid. We were all down at the Buffalo Hump gong match at Desert Sportsman shooting range in Las Vegas. This is the fourth time Preacher and I have made the trip down, come to think of it I believe that Tumbleweed has been down as many times. We shoot from 200 meters out to almost 900's at

different shaped and size targets. The target at 200 meters is shot off hand. It's quite a bit bigger than the chicken we shoot off hand at the same distance at a BPCR match but still seemed hard to hit for some of us!! It was a 96 round two-day match with a day of sight ins the day before the match started. The course of fire was 6 targets, to be determined by the match director with 8 rounds on each. All in all it was a great match with the weather cooperating the whole time we were down there. It was like old home week for some of us with shooters we haven't seen in years. One of our dear old friends and serious mentor asked me if Preacher and I had become competitive or still just having fun, I assured him that things have changed and we were both shooting better then the last time we shot together. Well the final scores showed that Preacher had improved dramatically. When the smoke cleared Preacher had won both days of AAA category. I had the blocks on my scope come loose some time during the match and I came in dead last, but I still got a trophy, a baby buffalo and some lead and a pound of powder with the suggestion that I might practice with my gift!!!! This is a great match and hope some of you that are shooting long-range black powder will join us next year.
