#### From Jackpot Jerry –

In addition to Board Secretary I have taken over the main responsibility of being range master and organizing the stage writing. The placement of the steel for our August match was based on the distances and difficulty from this year's National Championship Winter Range match. The targets for this year's Winter Range were further out and the stages had fewer double and triple taps. The SSS board has adopted this style for the foreseeable future. The targets being a little further out and this shooting sequence lend itself to the "Gulch" venue. Speed with Accuracy will be the skills emphasized. The feedback from the August match was very positive about this slight change. Don't be surprised to see more of the challenging bonus targets in the near future.

We are working on the shotgun reactive targets so we can minimize the problems with golden BB's on the swinging pipes. This match they worked fairly well but we still need to work on the lanyards for the reset. Each time is a little better.

The board is also looking at using straw bales and other materials to create a safe separation between the shooting areas. The way we are now, we cannot safely have many down range activities. If we can get some safe separation we can start putting the Texas Star and Bird targets back into the mix.

We continue to look for a more permanent and better venue for our matches but in the meantime, we will continue to improve our current Gulch location to provide all of you with the most fun and safe matches possible.
