FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Per Reese River Ruby, our finances are as follows;

Checking Account - \$26,961.96

Change Bag - \$144.00

Outstanding bills or debts - \$0.00

We currently pay \$250.00 per month to KWS Entertainment (Dan Simpson, property owner) for rent of the Range.

United Site Services is \$58.75 per month for the outhouse. (We are in the process of changing that to work with the track folks.)

Jerry Thurman, aka "Jackpot Jerry", \$120.00 per year for the website.

NRA Insurance (mandatory) \$782.00 for this year. (May change next year.)

Anyway, that is how we stand right now. We had a big project this year with finishing the concrete slab in the Pavilion. Lots of good comments and feed back from people on how nice that is though. We are also working with Matt at the track to try and get water over to the Pavilion. Will keep everyone updated.
