I'm helping a friend sell an original Winchester High-wall model 1885 with a 4-digit serial number and a single set trigger in 38/55. It's equipped with Browning sights. This gun is competition ready!! With a crescent butt plate and fairly heavy barrel which shouldn't be an issue with the light kicking 38/55. I shoot a lever gun with a crescent butt plate in the same caliber. With a shoulder pad I can shoot it all day long. The rifle looks like a 100 plus year old rifle should with some dings in the wood and appropriate patina and ageing on the metal parts and a truly pristine bore. Come to find out Elrod had relined the barrel with a 14 twist barrel liner and this gun shoots!! Because of the 14-twist liner you can use heavier caliber bullets in it. It comes with plenty of extras such as bullets, cartridges and cartridge boxes, some powder, dies and brass in a nice toolbox.

The price is a firm \$1500.00 and well worth it. Give me a call to see this fine old piece of history.
